



Enclosed, please, find information about the Madison County Health Department Medical Reserve Corps and the two forms you need to complete in order to begin the volunteer application process. Once we receive these completed and signed forms, we will forward the Emergency Service and Disaster Oath on to the county Emergency Management Agency to be signed there as well. The Oath provides Workmen's Compensation if a volunteer is injured while on duty during a **declared disaster only**, not training sessions. Once the oath is signed by the Madison County Emergency Management Coordinator, it is then given back to our offices where it will be filed along with your application and kept confidential. Should you become a Medical Reserve Corps Volunteer, you will be notified about available training sessions.
